Dear Parents

We are pleased to have our First Holy Communion classes back and running after a hiatus due to Covid-19 and provincial restrictions. This means that we will be inviting students who have not received their First Communion to enroll. Eligible children are those born in the years 2012, 2013 and 2014.

(Note: Those who were enrolled in the 2019/20 group that never finished will be asked to return for these classes as well for a refresher and to complete all steps of receiving their First Holy Communion.)

We have changed the way that we will be having our classes this year due to the number of children that have to be taught and the schedules of students in the past. We will be having two teachers this year and will be splitting the classes into two. We will also be shortening our program to guarantee that there will be no absences due to school functions or extracurricular activities getting in the way. Please make sure that your child attends each day of lessons to ensure they do not fall behind and can receive their First Holy Communion with the other children.

Our program this year will consist of six weekends spread out from February until May. There are many lessons to learn, so we will be learning more than one chapter at a time and moving at a pace that all the children can keep up to as we go along. The schedule is as follows:
