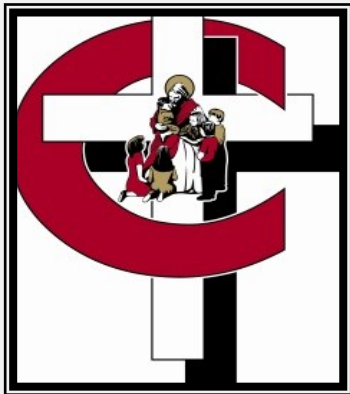

Student Services Information for Parents



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School Student Services

Christ the Teacher RCSSD #212 provide academic support to the diverse needs of students at both the elementary and high school levels. Student Support Services Teachers (SSSTs) provide resources, strategies, and intervention to help students increase academic achievement.

Elementary Student Support Services

SSSTs provide in-class, small group, and individualized instruction for students that require further support. The SSSTs will collaborate with parents and school staff to ensure that the educational needs are met for students who require intensive support.

Learning Achievement Coaches provide additional small group reading instruction for students that require further support while learning to read.

High School Student Support Services

At Sacred Heart High School, the SSSTs provide in-class and consultative support for students who can benefit. The SSST assists with classroom adaptations and monitors academic progress for students who require intensive supports. For students who require a tutorial period or quiet work space, the HELP room is available throughout the school day. The HELP room has an educational assistant available to assist students with their academic work as needed.

Dreambuilders High school

Dreambuilders provides high school academic programming for students who experience barriers while learning within the traditional high school setting. Students are provided support to develop academic, social, and employment readiness skills. Students graduating from Dreambuilders High School will have the skills required to continue into university, college, a trade, or employment.

Functionally Integrated Program (FIP)

A functionally integrated program is available at Sacred Heart High School for students with intellectual disabilities. The focus of the functionally integrated program is life skill development, work readiness skills, functional mathematics & literacy, and self care.

Division Student Services

Christ the Teacher Catholic Schools employs professional service providers for the purpose of consultation, assessment, and intervention planning for students who require further support. Services are available via consultation with your child's school staff. Our Service providers include:

Coordinator of Student Achievement & Supports

The Coordinator of Student Achievement and Supports is responsible for the leadership and coordination of student services within the school division. This includes ensuring needs are met for students requiring intensive supports in the areas of academic learning, emotional regulation, and behaviour.

Speech and Language Pathologists

The Speech and Language Pathologist provides assessment and programming services for students that require further support with communication, language, speech, voice, swallowing, fluency, hearing, and/or related challenges.

Registered Psychologist

The Psychologist provides consultation and assessment for children with learning, emotional, and behavioural needs.

School Counsellors

The role of the School Counsellor is to help students resolve personal, emotional, and social problems that interfere with their adjustment to school or their academic progress. School Counsellors provide students with opportunities for individual counselling, group work, and classroom presentations as needed.

Occupational Therapist

The Occupational Therapist provides assessment and consultation in the areas of self regulation, fine motor skills, visual perception, and sensory regulation to assist children in improving their success at school.

Physical Therapist

The Physical Therapist provides assessment and consultation specific to gross motor skills and mobility to assist children in improving their success at school.
