On **Monday, March 22** your child will be bringing home his/her **Term 2 Student Progress Report**. The purpose of the progress report is to communicate your child's progress with you. The student progress report reflects your child's achievement and effort with the specific strands being taught from the curricula. It is important to keep in mind that the progress report is one part of a reporting system. Conferences are also an excellent opportunity for the sharing of additional information and examples of your child's work.

Conferences for Term 2 will continue to look a little different than they have in the past. Families will be invited to view student's work, in the form of a portfolio, at home with their child. The work that the children will showcase demonstrates their effort, progress and achievement. It is our hope that the sharing of the learning journey will provide you with the evidence of your child's growth in his/her schoolwork and support for the achievement scores on the progress report.

In addition to the sharing of a learning portfolio, teachers will meet with each family (either virtually or with a phone call) regarding student progress and goals for the third term. Classroom teachers will be communicating with families regarding the format of these conversations. These conferences will take place from 4-7pm on Tuesday, March 23 and Wednesday, March 24.

Theodore Court Case Appeal Decision

On February 25, 2021, the Supreme Court of Canada dismissed Good Spirit (Public) School Division's application for leave to appeal the Theodore case to the Supreme Court of Canada. This means that the unanimous decision of the Saskatchewan Court of Appeal that overturned the April 2017 trial decision stands. Good Spirit has exhausted their legal options, and the decision of the Appeal Court remains the law in Saskatchewan—which can be considered a victory for both religious and parental rights and freedoms.
