Term II SPR and Conferences

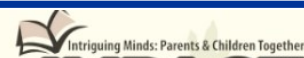
On **Monday, March 18** your child will be bringing home a **Term II Student Progress Report**. The purpose of the progress report is to communicate your child's progress with you. The student progress report reflects your child's achievement and effort with the specific strands being taught from the curricula. It is important to keep in mind that the progress report is one part of a reporting system. Conferences are also an excellent opportunity for the sharing of additional information and examples of your child's work.

Conferences for Term 2 will look similar to our first term. Families will be invited to come to the school, with their child, to view student work samples that demonstrate their effort, progress and achievement and engage in dialogue about success and next steps. It is our hope that the sharing of the learning journey will provide you with the evidence of your child's growth in his/her schoolwork and support for the achievement scores on the progress report.

These conferences will take place from 4-7pm on Wednesday, March 20 and Thursday, March 21.

A note will be sent home shortly for families to identify the evening that works better for them.
