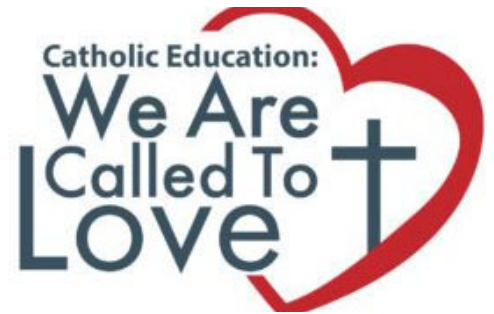
Dear Families,

### French Immersion (Grades 1-4)

### Kindergarten

If you have a child born in **2019** or know someone in our attendance area who does, now is the time to register for Kindergarten. You may pick up a registration form by calling Ms. Bartake or Mrs. Adams at the office. We need the information early in order to plan for the 2024-25 school year.

The child must be 5 years old by December 31, 2024 to be eligible to attend kindergarten this fall.

More information about Kindergarten will be sent to registered families before the end of May.

### Pre-Kindergarten

If you have a child who will be **3 or 4** years old in 2024, they are eligible to apply for Prekindergarten. We follow Ministry policy for prekindergarten enrolment, ensuring that children meeting prekindergarten criteria are given first opportunity. Children who attend a licensed childcare facility are eligible for prekindergarten this year.
