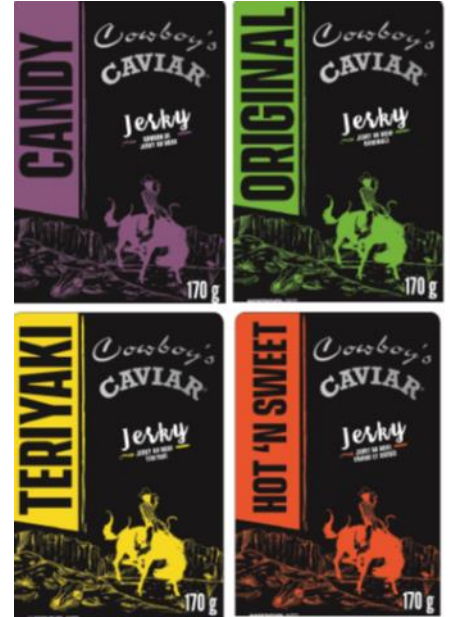


St. Mary's School SCC Fundraiser

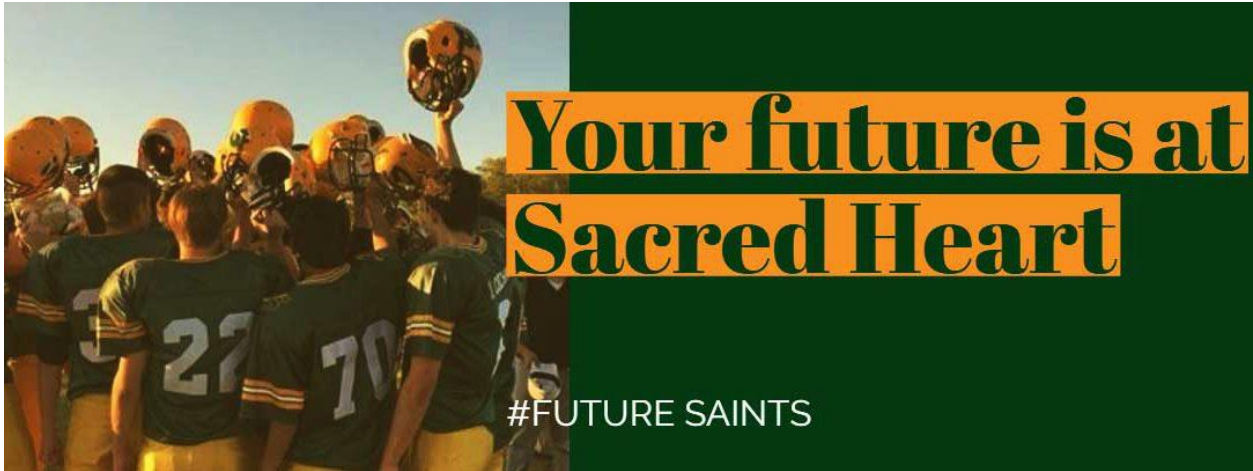
