Audition date will be early/mid September and our first class will be shortly after that. We will meet twice a week in the 1st semester (Tuesday and Thursday) from 3:15 – 5:15. and once a week on Tuesdays in the second semester also 3:15 – 5:15. Please choose an audition time that will LEAST conflict with your classes and inform your teachers prior to your audition that you will be missing class. **Please arrive 5 minutes early to your audition.** You get 15 minutes so be sure to give us your best!!! If you cannot make it to your audition, let us know immediately. Do not just **NOT** show up. **Be prepared; all forms completed and signed, and have all the equipment or music (including picks, sticks, sheet music, etc.) you need.** **You will be notified by email with the results of your audition. Please ensure that your email address and that of your parents is correct.**

Vocalists:

- You will sing with a microphone but you may also be asked to sing without one.
- You will be asked to demonstrate your vocal range
- Prepare to sing both the melody and harmony to at least one song

Keyboards: (Equipment will be provided)

- You will be expected to demonstrate your proficiency so choose songs that show that
- You will be expected to play the music as written as well as to improvise from just lyrics and chords

Guitars: (Equipment will be provided)

- You will be expected to demonstrate your ability to play lead (riff or melody) as well as chords.
- You will be expected to play a wide array of chords as well as play following a chord pattern we give you

Percussionists: (Equipment will be provided)

- You will be expected to demonstrate your skill and proficiency as well as your intuition and sensitivity when playing.
- We ask that you demonstrate an ability to use a wide array of the percussion pieces available to you. You may also bring your own cymbals or any other pieces you want to use. Bring your own sticks.

For your audition you **MUST:**

1. play/sing **one** of the songs listed below – We've given you the sheet music but if these arrangements are not what you need, search sites you have found to be the most helpful for material.
2. perform **one** song of your own choosing. Make sure it highlights your vocal/instrumental abilities. Provide us with the lyrics & chords or sheet music, if possible. This should also be a song that we could possibly learn next year. If you were in Channel 22 last year, your chosen song should NOT be a song you did in 2023-24.
