Core French (K -8)

Core French is a second language program for students in Kindergarten to Grade 8. In this program, French is taught as a subject or course. Students that participate in this program will be able to understand and use the French language in familiar situations.

Students are taught in fun and motivating ways including games, themes, and group work.

Students will also learn an appreciation of the Francophone culture and its place in Saskatchewan, Canada, and around the world.

French Immersion (Grade 1-8)

French Immersion is a second language program in which French is the language of instruction. Students are immersed in the French language most of their day in Grade 1 and 2 with formal English instruction beginning in Grade 3. Grade 1 and 2 curriculums are oral based with a focus on learning vocabulary and building an appreciation for the French language and culture.

The aim of French Immersion is functional bilingualism where graduates are able to communicate comfortably while maintaining their skills in their first language.

Why Learn French?

Learning another language is beneficial in many ways:

1. Opens doors to career opportunities and travel in all parts of Canada and in any of more than 100 countries around the world where French is spoken
2. Acquiring knowledge of other peoples and cultures which contributes to tolerance and open-mindedness
3. Strengthens a child's skills in their mother tongue
4. Enhancing feelings of identity and self-esteem

5. Developing learning skills they can use for the rest of their lives. Researchers say that children who learn a second language have improved problem-solving skills
6. Developing the ability to handle abstract ideas – from algebra to theories to history
7. Improving their cognitive development, reasoning, and ability to think creatively and divergently
8. Learning a third or fourth language more easily
9. Improving memory and attention skills

Who can register in French Immersion?
