## KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

Please **bring the following items to school** with your child in the fall:

- 1 - 1" 3-ring binder
- 2 -2-pocket folders
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 package of 24 wax crayons
- 1 package of 8 washable markers
- 1 pair of runners (Velcro or slip-on)
- 1 box of kleenex
- 1 large backpack with a zipper  
(be sure your child can easily manage opening and closing the bag by him/herself)
- 1 family photo (4" x 6")
- 4 Play dough - in plastic container with lid - purchased or homemade (see recipe above)
- 2 healthy snacks daily - fresh fruit or vegetable, yogurt, cheese and crackers  
(no fruit juice, drinks, bars, chips, candy, cookies, etc.)
- 1 lunch kit if staying for noon lunch
- 1 change of clothing to have available at all times (pants, shirt, underwear and 2 pair of socks) in a Ziploc bag, labelled with your child's name; this will stay in the bin in the Kindergarten bathroom

**IMPORTANT:** Please remove packaging from your child's supplies and label all of your child's belongings (do not use all capital letters when printing your child's name, eg. Jane not JANE)
