TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3rd: FIRST DAY OF CLASSES

- ☺ Students are to arrive at school between 8:30 a.m. and 8:40 a.m.
- ☺ Class Lists will be posted at the school and classroom entrances indicating the student's homeroom
- ☺ Students are to proceed to their assigned Homeroom Classroom and be prepared to enjoy their first day of classes. Our school day will begin with first bell at 8:50 a.m. - **classes will begin at 8:55 a.m.** Noon break is from 11:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. **Classes will end for the day at 3:20 p.m.** to accommodate bus schedules

PERSONAL SUPPLIES TO BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL BY YOUR CHILD:

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THE ABOVE SUPPLIES SHOULD BE ON HAND FOR THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES

- CLOTHING:** ⇒ Again, all children need 2 separate pairs (indoor and outdoor) of runners (NO SCUFF, NO SKATER RUNNERS FOR INDOORS).
⇒ ALL SUPPLIES AND CLOTHING MUST BE LABELLED WITH STUDENT'S NAME BEFORE BEING BROUGHT TO SCHOOL.
