FIRST DAY OF CLASSES

- Students are to proceed to their assigned Homeroom Classroom and be prepared to enjoy their first day of classes. BASIC SCHOOL SUPPLIES PROVIDED BY ST. PAUL'S SCHOOL

The Christ the Teacher School Division is committed to keeping the school start-up costs for our families lower by providing each child with some basic consumable school supplies. Each student in our division will receive a "start-up" package of school supplies that includes: duo-tangs, pencils, a glue stick, and an eraser.

PERSONAL SUPPLIES TO BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL BY YOUR CHILD - PLEASE LABEL (see note below):

- 1 box of Crayola pencil crayons (24)
- 1 box of Crayola fine-tip washable markers
- 1 container or pencil case for pencils, crayons, etc.
- 1 30 cm strong plastic metric Ruler
- → 2 red ink ball point pens
- → 4 blue or black ink ball point pens (NO multi-coloured pens)
- → one pair of each indoor and outdoor runners
- → 2 boxes of Kleenex (150s)
- → 1 Collins Gage Canadian Dictionary (soft cover) (students may already have this dictionary from previous grade)
- → 1 white-out (<u>tape only</u>)

→ a school bag

- (big enough for transporting library books, etc.)
- 200 sheets lined looseleaf
- → 1 pkg. looseleaf reinforcements
- → 1 pkg. looseleaf dividers
- 2 2" binder (no larger and no zippers)

- $1 1\frac{1}{2}$ binder (no larger and no zippers)
- 1 basic calculator
- 2 highlighters
- 1 Staedtler personal pencil sharpener with lid
- 1 combination lock (for gym locker) (optional)
- 1 Thesaurus
- 1 pair of scissors
- → 1 2-pocket folder
- 1 ultra-thin black Sharpie marker
- 1 sketchbook 11" \times 8 ½" or 27.9 cm \times 21.6 cm *use from last year
- → personal computer headphones (in a labelled, Ziploc bag)
- → 1 Good News Bible (paperback) previous St. Paul's students have received a Good News Bible in Grade 4; new Grade 4 to 8 students to the Christ the Teacher system will be provided with a complimentary Bible

THE ABOVE SUPPLIES SHOULD BE ON HAND FOR THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES

A \$80.00 band fee is collected from Grade 8 band students only. (\$40 extra for BAND FEE: shirt if needed) Cash or cheque to "Christ the Teacher R.C.S.S.D. No. 212"

Again, all students require separate indoor and outdoor runners (NO SCUFF, CLOTHING: NO SKATER RUNNERS FOR INDOORS).

GYM CHANGE CLOTHES (T-shirt, sweats, shorts) ARE REQUIRED.

ALL SUPPLIES & CLOTHING MUST BE LABELLED (STUDENT'S NAME) BEFORE BEING BROUGHT TO SCHOOL.

Students do not require MASKING TAPE or SCOTCH TAPE - these are <u>NOT</u> to be brought to school.
