## **Scripture and Church Teachings (ST)**

STK.1 Make connections between experiences or explorations and Bible stories or scriptural passages.

ST1.1a Represents a personal connection with a scripture quotation or story.

### **Prayer and Celebration (PC)**

- PCK.1 Examine faith symbols and practices related to liturgical seasons, including those associated with Lent, Easter, and Pentecost.
- PCK.1a Demonstrates an awareness of faith symbols related to liturgical seasons, including those associated with Lent (e.g. cross, purple cloth, water, ashes, oil, palm), Easter (e.g. light/candle, white cloth, flowers/lily, water, Easter bread), and Pentecost (e.g. wind/breath, red cloth, fire).
- PCK.1b Demonstrates several faith practices (e.g. the sign of the cross, personal prayer, daily prayer, stations of the cross).
- PCK.2 Participate in a variety of school or classroom religious celebrations.
- PCK.2a Contributes to classroom or school religious celebrations or events.
- PCK.2b Demonstrates appropriate verbal responses and gestures (e.g. blessing postures, hand gestures, kneeling) during school or classroom religious celebrations.

## Witness (WS)

#### WSK.1 Express one's identity.

WSK.1a Represents who he/she is today (e.g. physical characteristics, feelings, capabilities, important groups (i.e. family, Elders, senior citizens, friends, children's liturgy, storytellers, classmates, members of activity groups).

### WSK.2 Affirm freedom to express appropriately likes and dislikes.

WSK.3a Expresses likes and dislikes in respectful language, gestures, and activities.

#### WSK.3 Engage in the life of the classroom or school community through acts of service.

WSK.2a Welcomes opportunities to participate in a school or classroom caregiving project.
