THREAT - RISK GUIDELINES

The Christ the Teacher School Division requires that all threats be treated seriously. A **threat** is an expression of intent to do harm or act out violently against someone or something. It can be written, spoken or symbolic, such as a hand gesture. A “threat” may include words or actions to intimidate, intent to inflict harm, harass or bully other persons or damage property.

All “threats” will be assessed. The school Threat Assessment Team will determine the appropriate interventions and disciplinary actions to be taken. Please refer to school division administrative procedure AP 354 Threat Assessment Protocol for further information.
