Notes from the April 20, 2020 Regular Meeting of the Christ the Teacher Roman Catholic School Division (CTTCS) Board of Education.

2020-2021 School Calendar Approved

The 2020-21 school calendar, developed in collaboration with Good Spirit School Division, Good Spirit Teachers' Association, Christ the Teacher Catholic Schools, and the Christ the Teacher Teachers' Association was approved by the Board. Highlights of the calendar include a student start date of September 1, 2020, an extended Remembrance Day holiday, a 2-week Christmas break, a 5-day February break for students and staff, a 10-day Easter break, and the final Administration Day on June 30, 2021. Mill Rates Set

The Board approved a motion exercising its constitutional right to levy Education Property Tax and set Education Property Tax mill rates. The Board adopted the potential provincial Education Property Tax mill rates as set by the Lieutenant Governor in Council for the 2020 taxation year.

School Community Councils Elections

Typically, elections for School Community Councils occurs each Spring for vacant or expiring positions. The Board determined that deferring the elections to the Fall of 2020 would improve community engagement in this important process. A motion was passed to defer the SCC nomination and election process to the Fall of 2020.

Review of Subdivision Boundaries

A motion was passed to reduce the number of Board Members from ten to eight trustees, with one trustee reduced from the City of Yorkton and one trustee reduced from the City of Melville, effective School Board elections 2020.
