Band & Choir Concerts

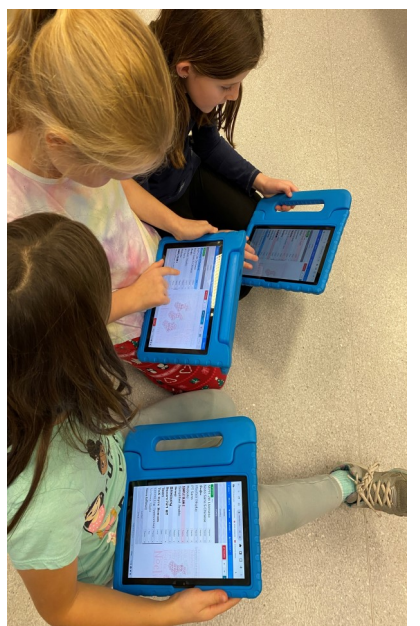
